This is a useful tool we created and launched about 10 years ago that enables healthcare provider organizations to self-evaluate the development and growth of their supply chain operations. Initially and for the first few years, SCMAT was administered by BLF through the Board of Directors until we migrated it to a self-assessment exercise. We paused during the pandemic and then decided to incorporate elements and lessons learned during the COVID-19 years so that organizations could assess their supply chain operations in a "post-pandemic" world.
