## Robert A. Simpson Scholarship

The **Bellwether League Foundation's (BLF)** Robert A. Simpson Scholarship is available to any healthcare supply chain professional working in a healthcare provider, manufacturer, distributor, group purchasing organization (GPO) or consulting firm or is a student pursuing academic studies in a field related to healthcare supply chain. Exposing developing or new professionals entering healthcare supply chain roles and recruiting students in undergraduate, graduate and post-graduate programs in a college or university setting to consider a career in healthcare supply chain are vital to advancing our profession.

The **Robert A. Simpson Scholarship** recognizes career and professional mentoring for supply chain advancement. The Simpson Scholarship honors a retired Bellwether who during his illustrious career actively mentored students, colleagues and fellow professionals on supply chain performance excellence. Simpson was inducted into the Bellwether Class of 2012.

Scholarships will be reviewed on merit of interest provided on the application and will be awarded to recipients based on funding availability. Here are the specific details of the scholarship:

- The scholarship is designated for healthcare supply chain leaders in providers, manufacturers, distributors, group purchasing organizations and consulting firms or for college students currently enrolled at least part-time in an accredited supply chain-related degree program. The curriculum must be related to supply chain practices, finance, analytics, leadership or ethics and professionalism with a preferred emphasis in healthcare.
- Any special circumstance outside of the stated requirements should be directed to the Bellwether League Foundation's Executive Director for internal review.
- Applicants must fully complete the required scholarship application and provide the necessary supporting documentation as indicated.
- Scholarships may only be awarded to an individual once. No repeat applications will be accepted in subsequent years.
- For student applications the applicant or nominator(s) must submit a letter of enrollment verification from the school's registrar or current official class schedule along with the application package.
- Applications may be submitted on behalf of a qualifying individual by a current member of the Board of Directors or Advisory Council.

**Scholarship Application Timeline:** Scholarship Applications will open on midnight, July 1, and close at midnight, August 31. Awarded applicants will be notified by September 30.
